### Introduction

In recent years, the role of the podiatrist has become increasingly important as our population ages with a consequent increase in onset of chronic diseases. Podiatrists deal with the diagnosis, treatment, rehabilitation and prevention of medical conditions of the feet and lower limbs. However, due to the small number of skilled podiatrists in the healthcare industry, there is a need to equip existing healthcare workers with the required skills and knowledge to become Podiatrist Assistants to meet the increasing demand.

HMI Institute of Health Sciences is offering the module “**Assist patients with nail cutting**” in the WSQ Competency Framework for Healthcare Support (Podiatry Support). This is one of the several modules that lead to the attainment of a WSQ Higher Certificate in Healthcare Support (Podiatry Support).

Upon completing the training program, the participant will have the skills and knowledge required to perform nail cutting in the appropriate manner for patients with various types of podiatry issues.
