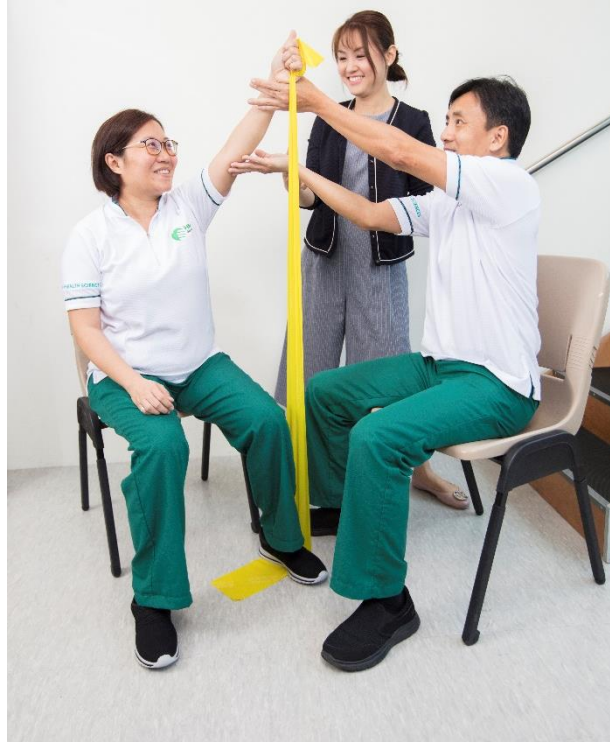


SG UNITED SKILLS PROGRAMME FOR THERAPY ASSISTANT
